<u>CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:</u> The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dudley at 6:03pm. Those present were:

 required for the elected officials. The election will be held in the Lake View Municipal
 Complex and the city needs poll workers.
- Fire Station #2 Grant- Mayor Dudley stated the foam portion of the project has been completed and the process has begun to get the City reimbursed for the funds.
- Safe Room RFQ's- Mayor Dudley stated that the RFQs have been published and the date to have everything in is July 16th at 10:00am. The RFQs have been published in a newspaper, at the Club, DJ's, at the Fire District and outside City Hall.

NEW BUSINESS:

• Meeting Request (Councilmember Hudson) – Councilmember Hudson provided an update on the request for a meeting by Senator Allen and Rep. Bill Lamb; stating that he reached out to Sen. Allen to continue discussions in public meeting. Per a statement from Sen. Allen read from his phone, Council member Hudson stated: "Ben, Rep. Lamb and myself decided not to engage in a public hearing since there is a legal issue pending. It was our hope that we could meet with you and other members of the council members, individually, to discuss the solution that the entire council could pass a resolution to move forward with the Exit 100 bridge replacement.

Councilmember Hudson summed up his response: "Hey, can't guarantee the willingness of council members to meet individually, though we're all here, that's why we have work sessions, why we have meetings, so we can talk through it, discuss it. Hey I can, definitely, get you pending on the schedule for July 12th, just let me know; which is today." I never did hear anything back. If I hear anything back, I will let the council know but I think we can remove this from the topic of issues

Mayor Dudley stated that the bridge at Exit 100 is being installed by ALDOT, not by the City of Lake View, the property around where the bridge is going in is not in the City of Lake View's corporate limits and does not belong to Lake View. There are other issues
