APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by the Mayor to approve the agenda for the evening. Councilmember Celmer seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: Mayor Dudley made a motion to the minutes from the month of April. Councilmember Johnson seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**

- Abatement Updates- Mayor Dudley provided the details an update on the nuisance properties.
- Added Position – Mayor Dudley made a motion to table the discussion until the next work session in August. Councilmember Johnson seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**
- LV Sign on Tannehill Pkwy – Mrs. Johnson announced that she would take the lead on contacting someone to consider installing the sign.
- Animal Control Ordinance – Mayor Dudley made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 0206252026. Councilmember Celmer seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**
- Central Park Drive Paying -Mayor Dudley provided information regarding the proposals for paving Central Park Dr. Mayor Dudley made a motion to table the discussion until more details are gathered. Councilmember Celmer seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**

- Lake View Saferoom-Notice to Proceed – Mayor Dudley provided the information regarding the Resolution Accepting Bids Received for the Construction and Installation of the City of Lake View Saferoom. Mayor Dudley made a motion to accept Resolution No. 0107232026. Councilmember Hudson seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**
- McAdory Football Request- Councilmember Dudley made a motion to approve supporting McAdory Football via \$6500 sponsorship. Councilmember Hudson seconded the motion. **The motion passed unanimously.**

- Loss Control – Mayor Dudley discussed the training presented by the AMIC/MWCF and encouraged the Council and employees to attend.

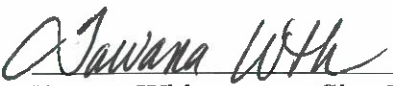
NEXT SCHEDULED SESSION:
