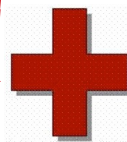

### **1. Jesus is great because He rescues us. (13-14)**

Colossians 1:13-14, “He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, 14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

1 Peter 1:17-19 (NASB), “If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one’s work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay on earth; 18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19 but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.”

Have you been redeemed from the domain of darkness? Are you a believer?

### **2. Jesus is great because He is the image of the invisible God. (15)**

Colossians 1:15, “He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.”

John 14:9, “Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”

### **3. Jesus is great because He is the creator of all things. (16-17)**

Colossians 1:16-17, “For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. 17 And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.”

Hebrews 1:2 (NASB), “in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.”

Genesis 1:26-27, “Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over

the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” 27 God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.”

Psalms 19:1 (NASB), “The heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands.”

John 8:58, “Before Abraham was born, I am.”

### **4. Jesus is great because He is head of the church. (18)**

Colossians 1:18, “And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.”

Matthew 28:18, “And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.”

Matthew 16:18, Jesus said, “I will build my church.”
