Family Devotion

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

Summary: Deuteronomy 32:48-52; 34:4-7

Since we live in a broken world, life is full of situations and challenges that frighten us. There are few things more frightening than the reality of death. This is the reality Moses is facing in the passages for this session. As we see Moses approach death in Deuteronomy, we will see that God's promises and presence give us the hope we need to face any situation.

.02 DO YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS OR WORRIES? HOW CAN YOU GIVE YOUR DOUBTS AND WORRIES TO GOD THIS WEEK?
