Family Devotion

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

Summary: Romans 6:1-14

As we have seen throughout our study of Romans, we live in a world broken by sin. Of all the many problems in our world today, the biggest is human sinfulness. Paul makes clear in Romans 6 that this problem enslaves us and leads to death. Simply put, to be truly free, a person would need to figure out how to shake off these two huge limiting factors—sin and death. Through Romans 6:1-14, your student discovered how our Savior has conquered sin and death so that we might live and find true freedom.
