Human Trafficking Walk: THIS Saturday, October 10

Meet at FBCTC Foyer by 9:45am. The walk begins at 10am. You need to go to the church website, fbcthecolony.org to register online to participate in any way. Invite others to join you!

1 in 4 victims are under the age of 18 Most victims are trafficked by people they know and it will happen in their own

The young the victim is the more money they are worth. Average age globally of a trafficking victim is 7-14

Due to COVID shutdown has caused a rise in online sexual exploitation of children

The difference April 2019 compared to April 2020 the cyber tip line has received an increase of 318% of child pornography calls 1-6 runaways become a trafficking victim

Runaways have increased due to COVID shutdown

It can take 4-6 years to "cure" and prevention is easier than the treatment

1-3 middle schoolers are being recruited 1-9 high schoolers are being recruited

USA is the #1 destination for Child Sex Trafficking

DFW is ranked #2 in the USA for Human Trafficking

Average age of Human Trafficking Victim in the USA is 13

You are serving the Lord Christ. 25 For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality. 4 1Masters, treat your bondservants justly and fairly, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven."
