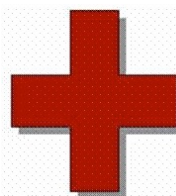

**“Exploring Thankfulness:
3 Responses of a Believer”
Luke 17:11-19; Colossians 3:17;
Psalm 9:1-2**

Luke 17:11-19 NIV, “Now on His way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. 12 As He was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met Him. They stood at a distance 13 and called out in a loud voice, “Jesus, Master, have pity on us!”

14 When He saw them, He said, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed.

15 One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. 16 He threw himself at Jesus’ feet and thanked Him—and he was a Samaritan.

17 Jesus asked, “Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? 18 Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?” 19 Then He said to him, “Rise and go; your faith has made you well.”

2. As believers we should do everything with thanks to God. Colossians 3:17

Colossians 3:17, “And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.”

3. As believers we should tell others of God’s wonderful works with a thankful heart. Psalm 9:1-2

Psalm 9:1-2 NIV, “I will give thanks to You, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonderful deeds. 2 I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing the praises of Your name, O Most High.”

Application:

Let’s take a minute and think to ourselves about something wonderful that God has done for us. And then, after a little few moments of silence, I’ll ask some of you to “tell of God’s wonderful deeds” with the group.

Think About It:

Colossians 2:6–7 NASB, Paul writes, “Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, 7 having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude.”

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 NASB says, “Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in everything; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.”
